A Kitchen Fit for a Queen

The design challenge was to create a kitchen and apartment with an old-world look for the clients' mother, who had come to live with them. The project started with an old barn beam for the ceiling and some wide-plank flooring finished with tongue oil. To achieve the desired look, the cabinets were beaded inset style and painted light green with distressing and antiquing. Also included were pullout wicker baskets, turned latches on the doors, valance leg and flush toes, and an old farm sink.

In keeping with the authentic theme, the designer hid the microwave behind a pocket door and concealed the refrigerator and dishwasher behind wood panels. Finishing touches included hard maple butcher-block tops, old hanging lights in the center of the room, and low-volt halogens under the wall cabinets and hutch.
